How to Provide Parental/guardian Consent

Please follow the steps below carefully to ensure your child is eligible to participate in the ENGAGE Project:

1. Read the Consent Document:

The parent or guardian should read and fully understand the information provided in the Parental Consent Certificate.

2. Decide on Participation:

If you agree to allow your child to participate in the ENGAGE Project, proceed with the steps below.

3. Print the Consent Form:

Download and print the Parental Consent Certificate for Child Participation.

4. Complete the Form:

Fill in all the required details on the certificate clearly and accurately.

5. Scan the Completed Form:

After completing and signing the certificate, scan the entire document to create a digital copy.

6. Submit the Form:

Upload the scanned form to the **ENGAGE online application platform**, or alternatively, submit it to the **contact teacher** who will assist with the upload.

7. Provide a Hard Copy:

Give the original, signed hard copy of the consent form to your child. They must bring it with them when reporting for the training at the designated regional university.

About ENGAGE

ENGAGE (ENabling Girls in AI and Growing Expertise in Data Science) is a training initiative by the University of Nairobi Institute of Tropical and Infectious Diseases (<u>UNITID</u>) and Data Analytics and Scientific Computing LAB (<u>DASCLAB</u>) in collaboration with the University of California San Francisco (<u>UCSF</u>). The trainings are conducted in partnership with regional universities across Kenya, namely, Pwani University, South-Eastern Kenya University, Meru University of Science & Technology, Dedan Kimathi University of Science & Technology, Kabarak University and Jaramogi Oginga Odinga University of Science & Technology. The main objectives of the program are i) to generate interest towards career pathway in data science and artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning among Form three girls ii) to build skills, confidence, and exposure in data science and AI among girls and young women. The program focuses on girls with a talent in mathematics. The training involves 10 days of residential training at any of the six regional universities based on distance and a two-days learning trip. There are no major risks that participants are likely to face as the project mainly focuses on training.

Data Protection Statement

Information We Collect

We collect the following personal data from applicants:

- Contact information (name, email address, phone number)
- Demographic information (date of birth, gender, health status, and other details)
- Academic background (education background, grades, and other academic records)
- Relevant programmatical information (attendance, performance, and sibling information)
- Any additional information provided in your application

How We Use the Information

The information collected will be used for:

- Evaluating your child's application for the ENGAGE PROJECT
- Communicating about the status of her application
- Administering and managing the training program
- Improving our program and tailoring it to participant needs
- Reporting and research purposes (in anonymized form)
- Compliance purposes with Legal and Regulatory requirements.
- For sensitive personal data as categorized under the Data Protection Laws, like health information and family details, we shall use them for the following purposes:

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- Project administration: The details will ensure fair training scholarship distribution.
- o Home visits and or verification with the relevant authorities.

Information Sharing

We may obtain and or share personal data as follows:

- ENGAGE may obtain additional information concerning the applicant's education and financial records, as needed to complete this application.
- ENGAGE may also communicate and release information to others who are involved in making decisions relating to the applicant's educational plans, including, and not limited to their previous, current, and future schools, and the Ministry of Education.
